Telephone Gallery is pleased to present it's next opening featuring Vancouver-based artist Andrew Oliver, presented by Amanda Crain-Freeland. The exhibition *Circle The Square* is a site-specific exploration of anonymous traces and casual gestures led and left by pedestrians in the inner city of Vancouver. Andrew Oliver (b.1991 Victoria BC) lives and works in Vancouver on the traditional unceded territories of the xwməθkwəy̓əm (Musqueam), Skwxwú7mesh (Squamish), and səliwətəɬ (Tsleil-Waututh) Nations. He graduated with a BFA from Emily Carr University with a major in painting in 2014. Andrews work draws inspiration from familiar and overlooked moments in our shared pedestrian environment. He is interested in action painting and conveying everyday themes of graphic diversion.
