Andrew Oliver (b.1991 Victoria BC) lives and works in Vancouver on the traditional unceded territories of the xwməOkwə'y əm (Musqueam), Skvxwú7mesh (Squamish), and səlilwətof (Tsleil-Waututh) Nations. He graduated with a BFA from Emily Carr University with a major in painting in 2014. Andrews work draws inspiration from familiar and overlooked moments in our shared pedestrian environment. He is interested in action painting and conveying everyday themes of graphic diversion.
